- How would you fit into business plan / vision?
- Track record for new hires?
- Competitive Environment?
- Quality of life

 - Call



Contract Elements

- Salary & Bonus
- Vacation
- Conferences / CME / GI Boards
- Benefits & Malpractice Insurance
- Duration of Contract
- Partnership / Buy in
- Termination
- NEED A LAWYER TO REVIEW



Range of Contracts

- 10 pages with sub clauses detailing aspects of job, partnership, ASC etc
- 2-3 page letter



Salary

- Generally \$100,000 \$350,000 initial
- Signing Bonus
- Productivity
 - Lead time to get registered with plans
 - Start the clock 3 months into job
- What insurance plans do others in group take? What would you participate in?



Time Off

- 3-4 weeks during 1st 12 months
- Board Review Course / Boards
- Specific Dates if Needed
 - Sibling getting married December 27 and thus need Christmas week off
 - Family Reunion in Hawaii during DDW
- CME



If Things Sour...

- Restrictive Covenants
 - Time (duration)
 - Scope (what you can and cannot do)
 - Place (area in which you are restricted)
- Non-Solicitation Covenants
 - Cannot solicit patients, member of patient's household, referral source to the practice
 - Cannot encourage patients to follow you elsewhere
 - Conflict with duty to patient???



Academics vs Private Practice

- No need to decide at outset
- Can explore both
- Same principles apply to each
