<b>PC1</b>	Gathers and synthesizes essential and accurate information to define each patient's clinical problem(s).
<b>PC2</b>	Develops and achieves comprehensive management plan for each patient.
<b>PC3</b>	Manages patients with progressive responsibility and independence.
<b>PC4</b>	Skill in performing procedures.
<b>PC5</b>	Requests and provides consultative care.
<b>MK1</b>	Clinical knowledge.
<b>MK2</b>	Knowledge of diagnostic testing and procedures.
<b>SBP1</b>	Works effectively within an interprofessional team (e.g. peers, consultants, nursing, ancillary professionals and other support personnel).
<b>SBP2</b>	Recognizes system error and advocates for system improvement.
<b>SBP3</b>	Identifies forces that impact the cost of health care, and advocates for, and practices cost-effective care.
<b>SBP4</b>	Transitions patients effectively within and across health delivery systems.
<b>PBLI1</b>	Monitors practice with a goal for improvement.
<b>PBLI2</b>	Learns and improves via performance audit.
<b>PBLI3</b>	Learns and improves via feedback.
<b>PBLI4</b>	Learns and improves at the point of care.
<b>PROF1</b>	Has professional and respectful interactions with patients, caregivers and members of the interprofessional team (e.g. peers, consultants, nursing, ancillary professionals and other support personnel).
<b>PROF2</b>	Accepts responsibility and follows through on tasks.
<b>PROF3</b>	Responds to each patient's unique characteristics and needs.
<b>PROF4</b>	Exhibits integrity and ethical behavior in professional conduct.
<b>ICS1</b>	Communicates effectively with patients and caregivers.
<b>ICS2</b>	Communicates effectively in interprofessional teams (e.g. peers, consultants, nursing, ancillary professionals and other support personnel).
<b>ICS3</b>	Appropriate utilization and completion of health records.
